| ■ | Turn off electricity and gas if instructed |
| ■ | Grab emergency bags before evacuation |
| ■ | Use family communication plan if separated |
| ■ | Check elderly family members and children first |
| ■ | Monitor official Malaysian emergency updates |

| ■ | Keep vehicles fueled during severe weather alerts |
| ■ | Avoid flooded roads and dangerous areas |
| ■ | Check emergency supplies every 6 months |
